

Birthright is a emergency pregnancy service offering positive help and assistance to girls and women faced with an unplanned or problem pregnancy. Birthright services

are free, confidential, and available to any woman regardless of age, race, creed, economic or marital status.

We also provide baby blankets, hats and booties to Young Life. Young Life is a world class organization for kids, teens, and young adults. Working with youth allows the program the privilege of talking to them about the good news of Jesus and His love for them. Kids' lives are dramatically impacted when caring adults come alongside them, and they begin to see that their lives have great worth, meaning and purpose. A portion of this great program includes working with teen moms who are faced with the challenges of birthing and caring for infants.
